Alfa Romeo Art Show

The Artist(s)

All entries must be original works by the artist(s), and the artist(s) must be AROC members.



The Art

Original works of art may be submitted in any of the following categories.

Digital Art: This category includes any original work for which the original image, or the manipulation of other source material, was executed by the artist using a computer.

Fiber: All work crafted from fibers including basketry, embroidery, weaving, leatherwork, tapestry and papermaking. This can be wearable or non-wearable.

Jewelry: All jewelry whether the work is produced from metal, glass, clay, fiber, paper, plastic or other materials must be entered in this category.

3D Art: Original 3-dimensional works crafted from a single physical material, such as wood, metal, ceramic, glass, and works that incorporate more than one medium.

Painting/Drawing/Mixed Media: All 2D art, except Photography

Photography: Photographic prints made from the artist's original image, which have been processed by that artist.

NWARC reserves the right to reject any entry. All items entered must be completed and ready for display before being brought into the Art Show.

Note: No art from kits, molds etc. is permitted. No production work, however modified, is permitted.



Submissions

All artwork must be clearly labeled. Each two-dimensional piece must be labeled on the reverse with the artist's name and the name of the piece. Three-dimensional works should have either a label on the bottom or a tag with this same info.

The entry fee is \$10 for one to two art works, and \$5 for each piece thereafter. Registration of entries may be added to your convention registration any time until June 30, 2018.

Artists are responsible for their own insurance. Check your homeowner's policy; you may have appropriate coverage there. We will take reasonable care of your artwork in the show, but the convention cannot afford extra insurance for the Art Show.



The Awards

First, Second, and Third Place awards will be given in each category that has at least seven entries. For categories with four to six entries, we will give First and Second Place awards. Categories with less than four entries may be combined with other categories for awards as appropriate. There will also be an overall "People's Choice" award, chosen by paper ballot (included in registration packet).
